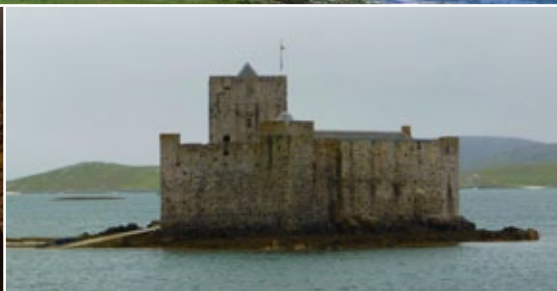

39 metre Kathleen Anne will be cruising the balmy waters of the Hebrides from June to August. The Hebridean Islands off the coast of Western Scotland are an ethereal cornucopia of clear waters, ancient castles, friendly fishermen, local festivals and secret coves. Best of all: no glitzy and ritzy crowds to negotiate and navigate your way through.

It is rare that the words 'remote' and 'accessible' can be used to describe the same destination. However, just a short flight from Scotland, the Hebrides are another world. Verdant mountains descend into deep, blue lochs; isolated and uninhabited islands are yours for the day. On the west coast, sandy dunes are thick with mohair grass, while the east boasts a deeply indented coastline with plenty of islets and anchorages. And, of course, there is proximity to some of the finest golf courses in the world.

The wildlife of the Hebrides is rich and varied, from sea birds to sea urchins, via otters, eagles and more. Sail amongst seals, whale watch, chat with the dolphins, or fish for your supper. All in pristine waters, where the only sound is the splash of the waves against the hull, the murmur of a puffin or the wind in the trees.

A mid-size Feadship SL39, Kathleen Anne, is perfectly sized for making the most of these waters. Exceptional deck space means that the sights are always accessible and the range of facilities onboard ensures that even on the most remote and uninhabited isles exceptional food, comfort and service are all constantly available on board.

Designed and furnished to an exceptional standard, Kathleen Anne has the atmosphere of a much larger yacht. Of her four guest cabins on the lower deck, two combine into a full-beam VIP with a private lounge. Both main and upper deck saloons lead out to large aft deck dining areas. With plenty of deck space at three levels, this is one of the finest sub-40 metre yachts for charter, in one of the most interesting locations this summer.
