GOLDEN FLEET EMBARKS ON A FOUR-YEAR GLOBAL REEF EXPEDITION

Starting in January 2011, the luxurious Golden Fleet is embarking on a four-year 'Global Reef Expedition' researching for the Living Oceans Foundation Science without borders programme. This expedition is in conjunction with the owner's foundation who has a passion "for preserving and protecting the fragile balance of the seas, not only for my children but also for future generations throughout the world."

She will visit some of the most remote and beautiful areas of the world such as the Bahamas, Fiji and French Polynesia, Australia's Great Barrier Reef, Thailand, Indonesia, and charter guests are welcome to join at any point along the route.

For those who are passionate about diving in remote locations and witnessing the wonders of the underwater world, joining Golden Fleet in 2011 is the perfect opportunity.

Devised and designed by a marine researcher, the Golden Fleet offers unprecedented luxury in combination with superb facilities, and unparalleled possibilities for ocean adventure.

The main luxury yacht is Golden Odyssey, where 12 guests are cosseted in more than 80m of space and are tended to by highly qualified and specialist staff, trained to deal with any eventuality. Her support vessel, Golden Shadow, an impressive adventurer in her own right, is comprehensively equipped with full diving equipment for up to 20 guests, a 2 man decompression chamber, a state of the art laboratory for marine research while also housing a myriad of tenders and water sports equipment as well as the Golden Eye seaplane. The last in the fleet is Golden Osprey, a fast and comfortable sports fisher able to navigate around coral reefs and areas inaccessible to the larger yachts.

In the Caribbean next year, charter the Golden Fleet through Edmiston at the special rate of \$700,000 per week instead of €700,000 next year. Alternatively ODYSSEY can be chartered separately at the rate of \$500,000 per week.
